Health Certificate

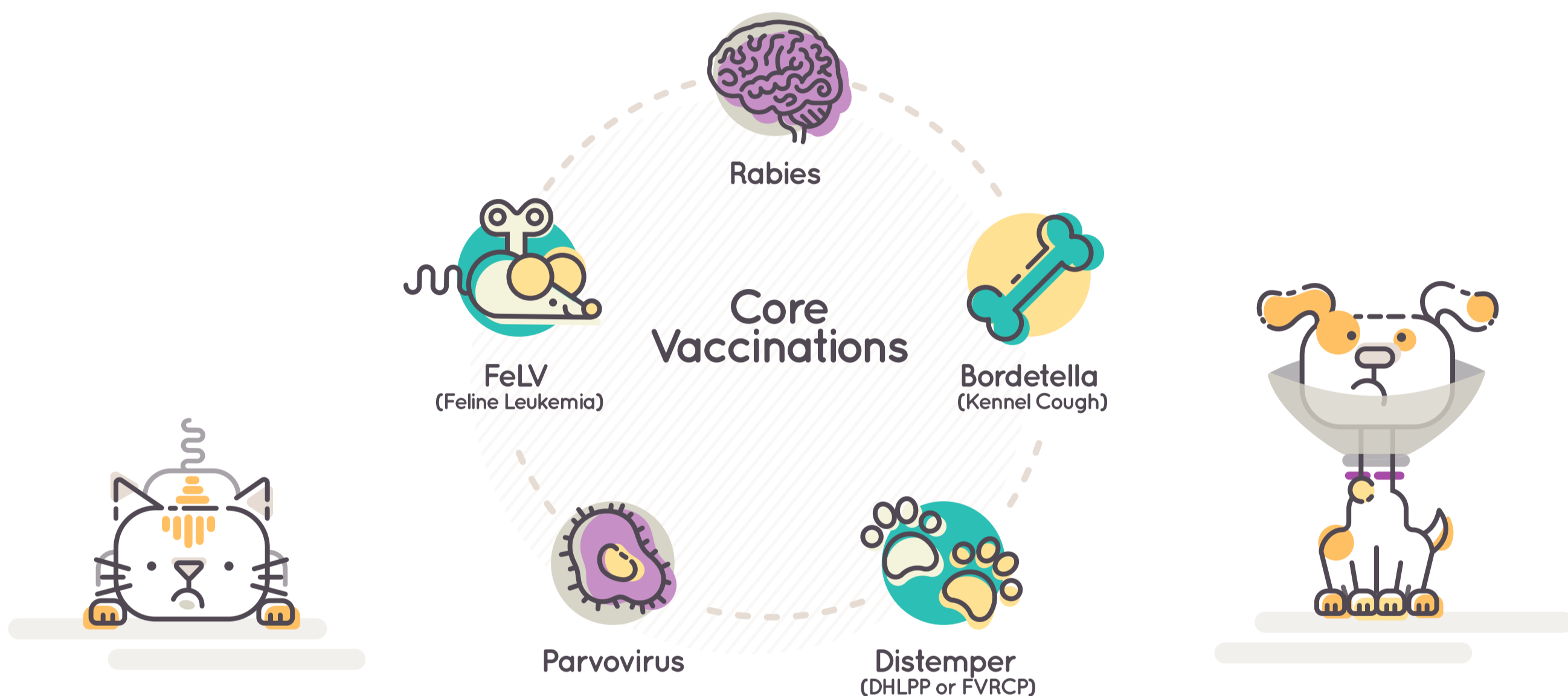
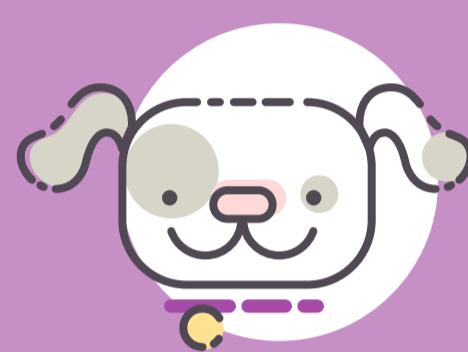
